E. San Antonio Street Bridge Light Installation

New Braunfels, TX – The City of New Braunfels has announced that the upstream lane of E. San Antonio Street on the Comal River bridge will be closed temporarily to allow for installation of the new light standards on that side of the bridge as part of the E. San Antonio Street Bridge Lighting Project.

On Tuesday and Wednesday, February 12th and 13th, flagmen will be stationed at each end of the bridge to allow traffic to flow in both directions, one direction at a time. Delays are to be expected between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. on those days. All lanes will be open outside of those hours.

The installation is expected to be completed within the time frame noted, weather permitting. Once the new lights are tested, installation of the lighting on the downstream side of the bridge will be scheduled.
