Tax Form Availability at Library

New Braunfels, Texas —The New Braunfels Public Library expects to receive tax forms and booklets (including 1040 and 1040A) from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) in the next 3-4 weeks.

Currently the library has received 1040EZ forms and booklets from the IRS, as well as the following forms: 3903, 4562, 4868, 8283, 8829, 8822, Schedules B, C, D, E, EIC, R and SE. Library staff members are also able to assist with the printing of forms from the IRS website.

“The Internal Revenue Service tells us that tax products ship throughout the filing season and late legislation may impact the timing of availability of some tax products,” said Gretchen Pruett, Library Director.

Free tax preparation assistance will again be offered by the AARP Foundation at the McKenna Events Center (801 West San Antonio Street) for taxpayers with low and moderate income - with special attention to those aged 60 and older. Tax assistance will be offered through April 13th on every Wednesday and Friday from noon to 4:00 p.m., and every Thursday and Saturday from 10:0 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
