Free Mobile Food Pantry at the Westside Community Center

New Braunfels, Texas — The City of New Braunfels will host a Mobile Food Pantry on the first and third Friday of each month, beginning in April 2013, at the Westside Community Center. The City is partnering with the San Antonio Food Bank (SAFB) to provide this service free of charge to qualified individuals and families in need residing within the City and its Extraterritorial Jurisdiction (ETJ).

On the days of the event, the SAFB Mobile Food Pantry will deliver fresh, frozen and non-perishable groceries to be distributed directly to those families. Each family will be provided with up to 80 pounds of groceries at each Mobile Food Pantry distribution. Individuals and families are qualified based on residence and income eligibility and will use a voucher provided by the SAFB to obtain their groceries. The Mobile Pantry will typically be on site for two hours and provide food assistance for up to 250 families.
