Summer Food Service Program – Food, Fun and Friends!

New Braunfels, Texas – In partnership with the San Antonio Food Bank (SAFB), the City of New Braunfels' Westside Community Center in continuing to make the health and wellness of New Braunfels children a priority by providing free meals during the summer months when school is not in session through their Food, Fun & Friends program. Meals are provided free of charge to children 18 and younger through the Texas Department of Agriculture's funded Summer Food Service Program.

Meal service will take place in the Westside Community Center Library, located at 2932 South IH 35, every week on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 1:00-3:00 p.m. and on the first and third Friday of each month beginning July 2nd and ending August 22nd. Participants will enjoy movies, crafts and other activities while receiving a healthy lunch that offers increased whole grains, reduced saturated fats and decreased sodium.
