Landa Park River Front Rehabilitation Project to Begin

New Braunfels, TX – City officials have announced that the retaining walls portion of the Landa Park River Front Rehabilitation Project will begin the first week in September.

The contractor, Austin Filter Systems Inc., is scheduled to begin on the Gazebo Circle side of the spring run - near the fishing pier - and proceed upstream, towards the wading pool area. The project will be addressed in several sections in order to minimize adverse impact upon park patrons and the environmentally protected waterways of Landa Park.

“We ask park patrons to be mindful of construction activities in this area,” said Adam Miche, City of New Braunfels Project Manager. “Although the new pedestrian bridge and Gazebo Circle will remain open to pedestrian traffic, there may be temporary closures during construction.”

The \$5.5 million project is made up of several components, including the replacement of 4,400 linear feet of stone retaining walls along the Comal River in Landa Park. Other significant features of this project include armoring of the Landa Lake dam, construction of a spillway that will flow into the old Comal River Channel, replacement of the wading pool pedestrian bridge, riparian landscape improvements and repairs to the Landa Park gazebo.

“We are thrilled to have the River Front Rehabilitation project underway and sincerely appreciate our patrons’ understanding for any temporary inconvenience during the project,” said Stacey Laird Dicke, Parks & Recreation Director. “This comprehensive project will address critical needs and help revitalize Landa Park for generations to come.”
