**Mayor Schedules Citizens' Forum on Railroad Safety**

**New Braunfels, Texas** — On Tuesday, September 17th, from 6:30–8:00 p.m., Mayor Gale Pospisil will host a citizens' forum at the New Braunfels Civic/Convention Center, 375 S. Castell Avenue. The program will address public safety related to railroad crossings and right-of-ways and the City's railroad quiet zones project.

Featured speakers include: Ivan Jaime, Union Pacific Railroad Director of Border Policy and Community Affairs; New Braunfels Fire Chief John Robinson; and the City's Capital Programs Manager, Octavio Garza.

This will be the ninth citizens' forum held by the Mayor since she assumed office in May of 2011.

"I'm looking forward to an additional opportunity to meet with citizens and to supply important information about railroad safety issues in New Braunfels," Mayor Pospisil said. "This is an extra forum being provided at the request of citizens who were interested in learning more about railroad safety."
