Walnut Widening Project Enters Final Stages

New Braunfels, TX – The City of New Braunfels has announced two upcoming temporary street closures in conjunction with the Walnut Widening Project entering into its final stages. The following 24-hour closures will allow construction crews to install concrete curbs, asphalt pavement and brick pavers:

- Phase 1 - W. San Antonio Street between Walnut Avenue and Hickory Avenue from September 14th through approximately September 26th
- Phase 2 - W. San Antonio Street between Walnut Avenue and Sycamore Avenue from approximately September 27th through approximately October 12th

These dates may vary pending weather and other factors. Detour routes will be posted in the area. Motorists and pedestrians are advised to use caution when negotiating this area.

“We have been working intensely with the contractor and their engineers to optimize the schedule and complete the project as quickly as possible considering the necessary multiple traffic shifts, detours and utility connections for underground conversions,” said Octavio Garza, Capital Programs Manager. “While we regret this temporary inconvenience to motorists, we are excited that the final pieces of the project are coming together. Completion of this major intersection – which is being done concurrently with work at multiple other project locations – will trigger the implementation of the final elements that will bring the project to substantial completion this fall.”
