Gruene Apple Channel and Roadway Improvements

New Braunfels, Texas — The City of New Braunfels has announced a road closure for Gruene Road from Sunnybrook Drive to approximately 200 feet north of the Gruene Road/Sunnybrook Drive intersection beginning Monday, September 16th in conjunction with the Gruene Apple Channel and Roadway Improvements Project.

The project includes the installation of storm drain and storm drain inlets along Gruene Road and channel repairs to improve ground/slope stability next to drainage easements.

This requires a full road closure for several weeks, with the potential of a partial closure continuing into early October. Access to businesses along Gruene Road will remain available during both the full and potential one lane closures.

For traffic not needing access to businesses on Gruene Road, a temporary, marked detour utilizing Sunnybrook Drive, Rapids Road and Hunter Road will bypass the construction zone.

Construction on this aspect of the project should be completed in the timeframe indicated, weather and other factors permitting, with the entire project scheduled for completion in the spring of 2014.
