**Detours Set for Comal County Fair Parade Street Closure**

**New Braunfels, TX** – The City of New Braunfels is advising motorists to expect delays and allow extra time when traveling near the downtown area on Friday, September 27<sup>th</sup>.

The 2013 Comal County Fair Parade will be held that day and the parade route will travel along San Antonio Street from S. Walnut to S. Union Avenue. The parade route will be closed to all thru traffic from 8:00 a.m. to approximately 1:00 p.m.

Traffic will be routed around the area to ensure a safe and fun event for all. The public is advised to follow the designated detour routes set out by the City along S. Seguin Avenue, Comal Avenue, N. Seguin Avenue and S. Walnut Avenue. These detours have been coordinated with the current street closures related to the Walnut Avenue Widening Project and the Seguin Underpass Widening Project.

Expect heavy vehicular and pedestrian traffic in the adjacent parade participant staging areas as well.

There will be no parking allowed along the parade route on San Antonio Street or around Main Plaza on that morning. All vehicles parked in this area will be towed per City ordinance. Signage will be placed out 48 hours in advance, to remind drivers of the temporary parking restrictions.
