New Braunfels, TX— The City of New Braunfels is pleased to announce that Municipal Golf Course General Manager Chad Donegan has earned a spot on the Southern Texas PGA team for the Texas Joe Black Cup Matches, slated for October 27th-29th at Royal Oaks Country Club in Houston.

Southern Texas PGA members compete in five events over the course of a year to earn a spot on the team. The final qualifier, the Southern Texas PGA Professional Championship, was held at Boot Ranch Golf Club in Fredericksburg on September 16th - 18th.

“Chad’s skills are a tremendous asset to the department,” said Stacey Dicke, Director of Parks and Recreation. “We are proud of his achievement and particularly pleased when he is recognized by his peers with acknowledgments such as this.”

The Texas Joe Black Cup Matches are an annual competition between the Northern Texas PGA and the Southern Texas PGA sections. The event was started in 1981 to honor Joe Black, a Snyder native who was completing his first year as President of The PGA of America.
