Fischer Park Ground Breaking Set

New Braunfels, Texas — The City of New Braunfels invites the public to attend the ground breaking ceremony for Fischer Park on Monday, October 14, 2013. The event will take place beginning at 11:00 a.m. at 1820 Old McQueeney Road. The property is located at the corner of County Line Road and Old McQueeney Road.

“We are thrilled to facilitate this substantial addition to the New Braunfels parks system,” said Stacey Dicke, Parks & Recreation Director. “Fischer Park will offer an amazing array of recreational opportunities for residents, as well as providing some relief from the heavy usage of Landa Park.”

Once completed, the 62 acre park will offer a wide variety of amenities including: hike and bike trails, playgrounds, a splash pad, fishing ponds, picnic facilities, a nature center and an outdoor amphitheatre.

City Council awarded the site work construction contract to MAC, Inc. and the building construction contract to Journeyman Construction, Inc. The total construction budget for this project is approximately \$8.77 million dollars, \$5.07 million of which is funded by the New Braunfels Industrial Development Corporation (4B Board). Pending weather and other factors, the project is expected to be completed in the fall of 2014.
