Free Video Game Design Classes Offered

New Braunfels, TX – The New Braunfels Public Library has opened registration for two, three-week long video game design classes for teens. The classes are offered on Wednesdays and Thursdays in December at the Westside Community Center, 2932 South IH-35.

Participants will use “Gamestar Mechanic” as the learning platform for video game design. Students will study the guiding principles for game design as well as systems thinking in a creative, digital environment.

Teens interested in the classes may register for either the Wednesday sessions (December 4th, 11th and 18th) or Thursday sessions (December 5th, 12th and 19th). Each class will run from 4:30 to 6:00 p.m.
