AACOG Weatherization Assistance Program Available

New Braunfels, Texas — The Alamo Area Council of Government (AACOG) Weatherization Assistance Program has funding available to help low-income people, particularly the elderly and handicapped, overcome the high cost of energy through the installation of energy conservation measures at no cost to the applicant. These measures include but are not limited to attic/wall insulation, and replacement or repair of heating and air conditioning equipment.

“This program is available to residents in both Comal and Guadalupe Counties,” said Charis Keenum, City of New Braunfels Grants Coordinator. “Participation is subject to completing the application through AACOG, demonstrating financial need and a structural assessment of the property.”

Qualification for Weatherization Services is a two step process. The applicant's total household income must meet federal income eligibility requirements and the home itself must qualify in terms of structural soundness (no major roof repairs, plumbing leaks, foundation problems, faulty electrical wiring or similar structural issues).
