More 2013 Bond Program Projects Underway

New Braunfels, TX – Three more projects, approved as part of the 2013 Bond Program, have recently begun: Klein Road Reconstruction; Blieders Creek/German Creek Watershed Improvement; and Wood Road/Landa Street Drainage Improvement Preliminary Design.

The Klein Road Reconstruction Project, listed in Proposition 1, reconstructs Klein Road from Klein Way to FM 1044. The project includes sidewalks on both sides of the roadway and drainage improvements.

The Blieders Creek/German Creek Watershed Improvements Project, listed in Proposition 2, reduces flooding in the Blieders Creek/German Creek watersheds, including Landa Park.

The Wood Road/Landa Street Drainage Improvements Preliminary Design Project, listed in Proposition 2, includes preliminary design for phased projects to relieve flooding in the areas of Wood Road, Landa Street, and adjacent streets. Options for future improvements will be determined as part of the preliminary design.

“Engineers are in the initial survey and research phase of the design process on these projects, and surveyors will be collecting early field data,” said Project Manager Will Martinez.

The City will hold several public meetings (after the first assessments) to collect comments, ideas and address questions on the proposed design options.
