## **Teen Court and NBPD Conduct Mock Trial, SWAT Simulation and K-9 Presentation**

**New Braunfels, Texas** — On February 28th, beginning at 12:30 p.m., the New Braunfels Community Teen Court program will conduct a mock trial with members of the New Braunfels High School Criminal Justice Classes. Students will serve in the role of jurors, clerk, bailiff, defense attorney and prosecuting attorney with Municipal Court Judge, Rose Zamora presiding.

Additionally, the NBPD SWAT Team, K-9 Unit and Operation Intervention will conduct simulations of emergency situations, drug enforcement and drunken driving simulations immediately after the Mock Trial. The program will conclude at 3:15 p.m.

“This has been a collaborative effort between the police department and the Court to educate the Juveniles and Minors about the Criminal Justice System. It has been a positive and enlightening experience for us all,” said Municipal Court Judge, Rose Zamora. “I have learned so much from the youth as I hope they have learned from us. These tours have served to give the youth an idea as to the services the law enforcement provides in our community as well as the Juvenile and Minor services provided by the Court.”
