### **Fischer Park Project Progresses**

**New Braunfels, TX** – Work at Fischer Park is continuing to move forward. Since construction started, contractors have completed initial demolition work, excavation for new streets and parking areas, the drilling of piers for the Nature Center and utility installations. Over the next two weeks the contractor, Journeyman Inc., will be pouring slabs and begin erecting the restroom and maintenance buildings.

“Although it may be difficult to see from the street view, Fischer Park construction is progressing and the park is beginning to take shape,” said Stacey Laird Dicke, Parks and Recreation Director.

Once completed, the 62 acre park will offer a wide variety of amenities including: hike and bike trails, playgrounds, a splash pad, fishing ponds, picnic facilities, a nature center, a large pavilion and an outdoor amphitheatre. The total construction budget for this project is approximately \$8.77 million dollars, \$5.07 million of which is funded by the New Braunfels Industrial Development Corporation (4B Board).

Pending weather and other factors, the project is expected to be completed by the end of 2014.
