Ninth Annual Flashlight Egg Hunt on April 12th

New Braunfels, TX - On Saturday, April 12th, the City of New Braunfels Parks & Recreation Department is hosting their ninth annual Flashlight Egg Hunt at Cypress Bend Park. The event is co-sponsored by Jo-Ann Fabric and Craft Stores and Texas State University.

Participants can pre-register for \$7 per hunter, or register at the event for \$10 per hunter. Check-in and registration begins at 7:30 p.m. and the first hunt starts at 8:00 p.m. Each hunter should bring their own flashlight, but bags will be provided courtesy of Jo-Ann Fabric and Craft Stores. In addition to thousands of eggs filled with treats, prizes will be given to children who find golden eggs during the hunts.

“We will have hunts for different age groups - 2-4 year olds, 5-8 year olds, and 9-11 year olds -starting with the youngest and working our way to the oldest group,” said Erin Flores, Recreation Programs Supervisor. “There will be carnival games for participants to enjoy while they wait for their hunt and the Easter Bunny will make an appearance for photo opportunities.”
