New Braunfels Public Library Offers Summer Volunteer Opportunities for Teens

New Braunfels, TX - The New Braunfels Public Library will again offer summer volunteer opportunities for teens with the Level UP Teen Volunteer Program. Up to 30 teens may participate in this program, which begins on June 10th and concludes on August 7th.

Those interested may sign up online on the teen page on the library's website, at www.nbtexas.org/library, or print applications are also available at the library's Help Desk. Applicants to the program must be between the ages of 13-17 and be able to commit to one volunteer work shift per week. Level UP Teen volunteer shifts are from 1-3 p.m. and 3-5 p.m. on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays.

Volunteers will work on a variety of interesting tasks, including selecting projects for the upcoming Maker Faire, working at the Maker Faire, assisting with art projects for the library, shelving materials and even sorting LEGOs.

"Research shows that volunteering leads to great outcomes for teens, both in school and in life after school," said Youth Services Librarian Kit Ward-Crixell. "The Level UP program is designed to be fun and fulfilling, as volunteers make friends with each other and work in groups on cool projects like the Maker Faire."
