Concentration Camp Survivor to Speak at New Braunfels Public Library

New Braunfels, TX - Inge Auerbacher, who survived imprisonment at the Terezin Concentration Camp in the former Czechoslovakia during World War II, will discuss her experiences at the New Braunfels Public Library on Thursday, May 22nd, at 7:00 p.m. In 1986, Auerbacher published a book about her childhood experiences entitled *I am a Star: Child of the Holocaust*.
