Added Seating for the Annual Fourth of July Fireworks

New Braunfels, TX – The City of New Braunfels announced additional seating for the annual Fourth of July fireworks display. This year only the Wurstfest Association will open the north gate on Elizabeth Street to allow guests to watch fireworks show from that area of the Wurstfest grounds. In addition, Wurstfest will offer free parking in the Lions Club Parking Lot, on the property next to the Knights of Columbus Hall on Landa Street.

“This is wonderful example of how the Wurstfest Association is a great community partner,” said Stacey Dicke, Parks and Recreation Director.

Festivities will kick off at 6:30 p.m. in Landa Park, with a free concert featuring The Groove Hounds on the Landa Park Dance Slab, and the fireworks will begin at 9:15 p.m.

“Due to the in-progress construction of the Landa Park Golf Course at Comal Springs renovation project, seating will not be allowed on the golf course,” said Stacey Dicke, Parks and Recreation Director. “The fireworks will be shot slightly higher to create visibility from surrounding areas including, Landa Park, Fredericksburg Fields, Hinman Island Park and Prince Solms Park.”

Elizabeth Street from County Club to Edge Water will be closed beginning at 7:00 p.m. and Elizabeth Street from Landa Park Drive will close at 9:00 p.m. during the fireworks display. Other road closures include Hinman Island Drive and Playground Drive from 7:00 a.m. until the end of the fireworks display.

The annual fireworks show is presented by the City of New Braunfels and sponsored by H-E-B. Residents and visitors are encouraged to come early and expect large crowds. For additional information contact the City’s Parks and Recreation Department at 830-221-4350.
