City Hosts River Recreation Public Input Meeting

New Braunfels, Texas — New Braunfels residents are invited to participate in a public input meeting on local river-related recreation on Tuesday, August 26th, at 6:00 p.m., at the New Braunfels Civic/Convention Center.

In the fall of 2013 City Council formed a River Stakeholder/Steering Committee to develop recommendations for improved management of the 2014 river recreation season. As a result of the committee's work, the Council ultimately moved forward with several initiatives in the 2014 season, including paid parking at Prince Solms Park, an increase in the River Management fee paid by river outfitters, and the implementation of a wristband system for river users.

“As the season winds down, it's important for us to review the effectiveness of our new and existing management practices in order to provide the best experience possible for our patrons and residents,” said Mayor Barron Casteel. “We encourage our citizens to take advantage of this opportunity to join us in an interactive meeting as we evaluate how we move forward.”
