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Comal Cemetery Bank Stabilization Design Project to Begin

New Braunfels, TX – City officials have announced that the geotechnical investigation portion of the Comal Cemetery Bank Stabilization Design project will begin Friday, August 22nd.

The design phase for the Comal Cemetery bank stabilization project consists of several components including geotechnical investigation, archeological investigation, final design, and construction document preparation.

Geotechnical drilling is scheduled to begin on the western end closest to Common Street and proceed, adjacent to the Guadalupe River, towards the cemetery office.

“The geotechnical and archeological investigations are important components of the project to ensure the absence of unmarked graves and provide design information about the existing soil conditions within the project area,” said Adam Michie, Project Manager.

The geotechnical investigation is expected to take approximately two weeks to complete, weather and other factors permitting.
