## New Braunfels Police Department Seeks Applicants for the Contractual Training Advisory Board

New Braunfels, Texas — The New Braunfels Police Department (NBPD) is required to maintain an active Law Enforcement Advisory Board to review and to provide direction to the Department's Training Coordinator for all of its contractual training needs. There are currently several Civilian Board Member vacancies and citizens who reside within the city limits of New Braunfels are encouraged to apply.

The Board establishes and reviews the proposed training courses and minimum attendance standards for any classes that NBPD will offer to Law Enforcement personnel through its Contractual Training Contract with the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement.

One-third of the board's membership is civilian. The term limit for civilian board member is five years and the board is required to meet a minimum of one time per year.

Potential applicants can review basic information concerning board members by searching "Texas Administrative Code Rule 215.7 Training Provider Advisory Board" on the internet. Advisory Board training will be provided to all selected members prior to their attendance at the first meeting.
