Trap Neuter Return Information Seminar Scheduled

New Braunfels, TX - The San Antonio Feral Cat Coalition will offer an information seminar for all who are interested in learning more about the Trap Neuter Return (TNR) program and how it can work to counter the over-population of outdoor cats in our community. The session will be held on Sunday, November 16th at the Westside Community Center from 2:00 to 4:00 p.m. in the Rahe Classroom. The Center is located at 2932 South IH-35 in New Braunfels.

The New Braunfels City Council recently passed an amendment to city ordinances which allow residents to use TNR methods to control the unchecked proliferation of community cats. The San Antonio Feral Cat Coalition is a 501 (c) 3 organization that is working with the City of New Braunfels and the Humane Society of New Braunfels to ensure that residents have the resources and training to work with feral or community cats safely and effectively.

All interested parties are welcome and there is no charge for the class.

“This is a new concept to many of our city residents, but the San Antonio Feral Cat Coalition has been a pioneer in working with all the partners in a community to control community cats. Their expertise will be invaluable in helping New Braunfels residents develop a program of its own,” said Library Director Gretchen Pruett.
