Landa Street Bridge Lights Project Beginning

New Braunfels, TX – City officials have announced that the Landa Street Bridge Lights Project is scheduled to begin next week. The bridge is located between the Wurstfest grounds and the Knights of Columbus facility, along Landa Street.

The scope of work includes demolition of the existing New Braunfels Utility light poles, construction of new vintage-look light poles, and installation of wrought iron fencing and lighting under the Union Pacific Railroad Bridge along the pedestrian walkway. The project is expected to take approximately 90 days to complete, weather and other factors permitting.

The Landa Street Bridge will experience some traffic delays throughout the duration of the project, with occasional lane closures and flaggers present. Drivers and pedestrians should be mindful of the construction activity, which will take place primarily on weekdays.

This initiative is funded by New Braunfels Mainstreet Partners and the New Braunfels Industrial Development Corporation (4B).
