### **City Seeks Input from Residents on Market Plaza**

**New Braunfels, Texas** – The New Braunfels Parks and Recreation Department is hosting a neighborhood input meeting on Thursday, April 9<sup>th</sup>, beginning at 5:30 p.m., at Market Plaza, located at 292 Tolle Street. Residents are invited share their ideas for the park. Market Plaza is a 0.7 acre park located in downtown New Braunfels and currently features benches, a drinking fountain and landscape bed.

“We hope to have a productive visit with the residents. It’s great weather for them to come out and enjoy some ice cream with us while we note their ideas and input,” said Stacey Dicke, Parks and Recreation Director. “To date, input has been sought from stakeholders including the Downtown Association, Historic Landmark Commission, Downtown Board and New Braunfels Utilities. We are excited to enhance this green space, and are eager to learn what the residents of the area envision.”

After review of the input, three design options will be developed and presented to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board for their consideration.

The New Braunfels Parks Foundation has identified Market Plaza park improvements as the recipient of proceeds from the 2015 Wein & Saengerfest. The Foundation previously funded the installation of irrigation at the site, using proceeds from the 2013 Wein and Saengerfest.
