New Braunfels, Texas — The month of May is “National Historic Preservation Month” and thousands of individuals across the country will be joining the celebration. The City of New Braunfels’ Historic Landmark Commission is celebrating by sponsoring its annual “Free Historic Museum Day” on May 16th from noon to 4:00 p.m. The following museums and historic sites will be offering free admission during this event: The Lindheimer Museum, The New Braunfels Fire Station Museum, The New Braunfels Railroad Museum, The Buckhorn Barber Museum, The Sophienburg Museum, The Museum of Texas Handmade Furniture, The New Braunfels Conservation Society, and the Historic St. Martin Church.

Additionally, the Commission is hosting the third annual Historic Property Scavenger Hunt, a self-paced hunt through the Downtown Historic District to locate architectural details. All correct entries will be entered into a grand prize drawing for a gift basket valued at \$300.

This year, the Historic Landmark Commission will also be hosting the inaugural Historic Photo Contest.
