Heavy Rains Prompt Closure of Comal River in New Braunfels

New Braunfels, Texas — Due to heavy rains and the resulting high and fast moving water, the Comal River in New Braunfels will be closed to recreation until 1pm on Sunday, May 17, 2015.

At that time, river conditions will be reevaluated and a determination will be made about whether recreation can resume or not. Another press release will be sent shortly after 1pm once that determination is made.

As of this release, the Comal River is flowing at over 650 cfs (cubic feet per second), and water has gone over the top of the Tube Chute dam.
