**Comal River to Remain Closed Sunday – Reevaluation Monday**

New Braunfels, Texas — With water still flowing over the Tube Chute Dam, and river flows expected to remain high due to continued run-off from rains on Saturday and early Sunday, the decision has been made to keep the Comal River closed to recreation for the remainder of the day on Sunday. River conditions will be reevaluated Monday morning.

The Guadalupe River in New Braunfels is currently flowing at over 1000 cfs, but still remains open to limited recreation, like kayaks and 6-man rafts. However, with flow rates above 750 cfs, city ordinances require anyone on the river to wear a life jacket. Contact local river outfitters for details about prime rafting spots, and use caution while on the water.

Schlitterbahn Waterpark is operating as normal, and most other local tourism attractions are also open today.
