Heavy Rains Force Closure of Comal River

New Braunfels, Texas — Due to heavy rains and the resulting high and fast moving water, the Comal River in New Braunfels will be closed to recreation for the remainder of the day Monday (May 25, 2015) and will be reevaluated again Tuesday morning (May 26, 2015).

At that time, city officials will consider river flows and debris clean-up before making a determination about when the river can re-open for recreation. Another press release will be sent once that determination is made.

As of this release, the Comal River is flowing at over 500 cfs (cubic feet per second), and water has gone over the top of the Tube Chute dam.
