Major Rollover Accident with Serious Injuries

New Braunfels, Texas — On June 6, 2015, at approximately 5pm, New Braunfels Police were dispatched to the 1900 block of South Seguin Avenue for a rollover motor vehicle accident. Once on scene, officers found a white 2007 Chevrolet Impala that had rolled over and crashed into the side of a nearby business.

The driver, identified as a 30-year old male from New Braunfels, was ejected during the crash. New Braunfels Fire Department personnel immediately began treating the driver and Airlife was called to the scene to transport him to University Hospital in San Antonio in critical condition.

The crash and ensuing investigation closed a portion of South Seguin Avenue for approximately 4 hours. The investigation revealed that the Impala was traveling at a high rate of speed, swerved off the roadway, and struck multiple elevated curbs, sending the vehicle into an extended roll. The vehicle came to a stop once it struck the side of the H2O Car Wash in the 1900 block of South Seguin Avenue. The driver was not wearing a seat belt at the time of the crash. Speed and alcohol were found to be contributing factors, and the accident remains under investigation.
