Callen's Castle All Abilities Park Public Input Meeting

New Braunfels, Texas – New Braunfels Parks and Recreation Department, in partnership with a citizen's group led by Lauren Clawson and the New Braunfels Parks Foundation, is inviting the community to participate in a public input meeting concerning the development of Callen's Castle All Abilities Park. The meeting will be held on Thursday July 9th from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at Real Life Community Church, located at 1615 FM 1044.

In December 2014, City Council approved a four acre site on FM 1044 for the future park. Callen's Castle All Abilities Park will feature special equipment that will allow children and adults, regardless of their abilities, to play together. Park amenities - such as swings and a merry-go-round specifically for wheelchairs, foam mats, a sensory area that incorporates textures and music, a playscape with ramps, an all abilities playfield and parking - will be finalized after public input.

"The meeting is open to all interested individuals, organizations and businesses who would like to learn about the project, offer input and be a part of the parks' creation," said Parks and Recreation Director Stacey Dicke.

New Braunfels Parks and Recreation will gather community feedback and present design concepts developed from the input at a second meeting on July 30th, from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m., at Real Life Community Church.
