## **Seniors Farmers Market at Westside Community Center**

**New Braunfels, TX** - In an effort to make fresh, nutritious food available to everyone, the City is partnering with the San Antonio Food Bank (SAFB) and local farmers this summer to provide fresh produce free of charge to qualified seniors and families in need through the Seniors Farmers Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP) and the WIC Farmers Market Nutrition Program (FMNP). Fresh local food will be available for purchase, and \$20 vouchers will be provided by SAFB to low-income seniors and families that receive WIC assistance. Vouchers will be provided on a first come, first served basis, and quantities are limited.

“Farmers Markets are good for our health, good for our community, and good for our economy,” said Gretchen Pruett, Library Director. “The next Farmers Market will take place on Friday, July 31st, from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., and the final one this season will be on Friday, August 28th, in the same timeframe.”
