All Abilities Park Public Input Meeting Set

New Braunfels, Texas – New Braunfels Parks and Recreation Department, in partnership with a citizen’s group led by Lauren Clawson and the New Braunfels Parks Foundation, is inviting the community to participate in the second public input meeting concerning the development of Callen’s Castle All Abilities Park. The meeting will be held on Thursday July 30th from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at Real Life Community Church, located at 1615 FM 1044.

City Council approved a four acre site on FM 1044 for the future park which will feature special equipment that will allow children and adults, regardless of their abilities, to play together.

“All interested individuals, businesses, and organizations are invited to attend this meeting where we will review design concepts and the preliminary Master Plan for the park,” said Parks and Recreation Director Stacey Dicke. “These were developed based on community input and ideas proposed during our first public meeting, where the public was invited to learn about the project, offer input and be a part of the parks’ creation.”
