Small Portion of Comal River Closed Due to Fallen Tree

New Braunfels, Texas — A large tree has fallen across a section of the Comal River in the area near Camp Warnecke, therefore, effective immediately, a small portion of the Comal River is now closed. That section (from the Garden Street Bridge to the Last Tuber's Exit) will remain closed until the tree is completely removed along with any other debris. That means all tuber traffic must exit at the Garden Street Bridge and local river outfitters have been notified of the situation. City Park Rangers will also be assisting tubers with exiting at the Garden Street Bridge. A contractor will be arriving to begin the tree removal process around 1pm and the process is expected to take several hours. Further updates will be provided once that portion of the river has been reopened.
