Meetings on Drainage & Erosion Control Design Manual Update Scheduled

New Braunfels, TX – The City of New Braunfels will initially host a public meeting for the engineering and development community regarding planned updates to the Drainage and Erosion Control Design Manual, including the new Low Impact Development Manual. This meeting will be held in City Council Chambers, 424 S. Castell Avenue, on Wednesday, September 16th at 6:00 p.m.

This session will focus on specific criteria changes and will include a detailed overview of the manuals. The proposed documents are currently available online for review and comment on the Engineering Division's website, www.nbtexas.org/engineering. City Engineering staff will be conducting the presentation and will be available to answer questions and address concerns.

All those involved in development projects in the City, and especially those tasked with drainage design, are encouraged to take advantage of this opportunity on September 16th to learn about proposed, upcoming changes.

A second meeting, for general public input, is planned for October 20th and will feature general information regarding the requirements for development, provide an overview of stormwater management in the City and will also incorporate an opportunity for the public to communicate areas of drainage concerns and issues with City staff in an open house format. City Public Works staff will be on hand to meet with residents and answer any questions concerning development criteria or general drainage concerns during this session.
