Controlled Gas Burn Off

New Braunfels, Texas — A controlled burn off of a large natural gas line will continue today and tomorrow.

Tulsa Inspection Resources is currently burning 450-gallons of natural gas contained in a 28-mile pipeline in the 1700 block of South Seguin Avenue (in the area behind the old Owens Corning plant).

Although there is no danger to the public, residents in the area may notice a large 30 to 40-foot pillar of flame and a loud noise coming from that direction as the company burns off that material.

The burn off is scheduled to continue through 8pm today and then resume at 7:30 tomorrow morning and, again, last until 8pm.

The City of New Braunfels Fire Department is on scene monitoring the controlled burn off.
