**Westside Community Center Mobile Food Pantry Fall Distribution Time Change**

**New Braunfels, Texas** — The City of New Braunfels will continue to host a Mobile Food Pantry on the first and third Friday of each month at the Westside Community Center. Beginning this Friday, October 2<sup>nd</sup>, distribution times will return to the normal fall hours of 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. The City has an ongoing partnership with the San Antonio Food Bank (SAFB) to provide this service free of charge to qualified individuals and families that are food insecure.

On the days of the event, the SAFB will deliver fresh, frozen, and non-perishable groceries to be distributed directly to families in need. Food vouchers may continue to be picked up at the following locations prior to the event: Westside Community Center Office, Westside Community Center Library, the main Public Library and the Salvation Army.
