Homicide Suspect Captured

New Braunfels, Texas — On today's date (Oct. 13, 2015) an arrest warrant for Murder was issued against 23-year old Federico Trejo Jr. for the homicide of 43-year old Domingo Perez Jr, who was found deceased outside of a gas station at the intersection of I-35 and Ruekle Road around 2:25am on this date.

Detectives with the New Braunfels Police Department have been following up on leads and collecting evidence since this morning's incident and with the assistance of the US Marshal's Lone Star Fugitive Task Force out of San Antonio were able to develop information that indicated Trejo had fled to a residential address in Killeen. The Killeen division of the US Marshal's Lone Star Fugitive Task Force was then contacted and they were able to apprehend Trejo without incident.

Trejo was then taken to the Bell County Jail and booked on a single charge of Murder, with bond set at \$500,000. He currently remains in custody in Bell County while awaiting extradition back to Comal County.
