**Lone Star Commuter Rail Project Public Input Meeting Set**

**New Braunfels, Texas** — The City of New Braunfels is hosting a public input meeting on the proposed Lone Star Rail Commuter Rail Project on Wednesday, October 21<sup>st</sup> at 6:00 p.m. at the New Braunfels Civic/Convention Center. The Center is located at 375 S. Castell Avenue.

The Lone Star Rail District (LSRD) is proposing a regional passenger rail service connecting communities along the I-35 corridor between the metropolitan areas of San Antonio and Georgetown. The project includes a proposed rail stop in New Braunfels.

As envisioned, the Lone Star Regional Commuter Rail Project would span approximately 120 miles across Williamson, Travis, Bastrop, Hays, Caldwell, Comal, Guadalupe and Bexar counties. The purpose of the project is to improve mobility, accessibility, transportation reliability, safety and facilitate economic development along the I-35 corridor in central and south Texas.

Representatives from LSRD, along with City staff, will be on hand to provide information about the proposed project and to take input from citizens.
