

DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the City of New Braunfels, Texas on the 30th day of October 2015, has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from major storms and flash flooding.

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of New Braunfels, Texas has determined that the extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NEW BRAUNFELS, TEXAS:

1. That a state of disaster is declared for the City of New Braunfels, Texas pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Government Code, this state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven (7) days hereof, unless the same is continued by consent of the City Council of New Braunfels.
3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.
4. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government Code, and this declaration, the City activates its Emergency Management Plan.
5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
