**New Braunfels Emergency Operations Center Flood Update
Debris Cleanup Information**

New Braunfels, Texas — The City of New Braunfels is continuing efforts to help residents affected by floodwaters by making further arrangements for debris removal.

Residents that have homes that were damaged by floodwaters and have debris that needs to be picked up, please contact the city to report your location. This can be done by filling out a quick form on the city's website by logging on to <http://www.nbtexas.org/disasterrecovery> or you can report your location by phone using the city's non-emergency information line at 830-221-4351.

Once those locations have been identified, the City Solid Waste Division will contact residents with a date they can expect crews to pick up that debris.

In an effort to expedite the debris removal process, please place all debris curbside in the following separated piles, including construction debris, vegetative debris, and large appliances. (See the attached graphic for further details.)

Do not place debris near, on, or under trees, poles, or other structures that would make removal difficult.

For brush that needs to be removed, please make sure limbs are no longer than 10' in length, and no more than 18" in diameter.
