City Seeking Citizen Input On-Line for Street Improvement Program

New Braunfels, TX - The City of New Braunfels invites citizens to provide input on the FY 2015-2016 street improvement program - through an interactive, on-line map – now through November 15th.

“Citizens are entitled to more than just government transparency, they also should be encouraged to collaborate and participate in decisions,” said City Manager Robert Camareno. “We are asking our residents to provide input; identifying roadways they feel should be evaluated for potential inclusion in the City’s street improvement program.”

A second annual public input meeting was held on October 27th, at the New Braunfels Civic Convention Center, to provide citizens with information on the program and to take their comments. The City has developed the on-line input initiative to provide those who were unable to attend the meeting with an avenue for expressing their opinions.

Those interested in identifying streets for evaluation can visit www.nbtexas.org/Streets_input where they will find a brief overview of the City’s Pavement Management program, listings of currently proposed street projects and directions for utilizing the Street Public Input interactive map.

“This is a user-friendly method that allows everyone to pinpoint problem locations on a City of New Braunfels map,” Mr. Camareno said. “We encourage everyone to provide their input and assist us in developing our recommendations for consideration by City Council, for roadways to be addressed in the FY 2015-2016 street improvement program.”
