**City Seeking Citizen Input on
Landa Street Pedestrian and Bicycle Facility Enhancements Project**

New Braunfels, TX – The City of New Braunfels is asking citizens to be a part of the input design process related to the Landa Street Pedestrian and Bicycle Facility Enhancements Project at an upcoming public meeting. The public meeting is scheduled for December 2nd, from 6:00 to 7:30 p.m. at the Landa Haus, located in Landa Park at 360 Aquatic Circle.

The project will focus primarily on improving pedestrian and bicycle facilities as well as complying with the Americans with Disabilities Act. The project route will be along Landa Street from the intersection of Walnut Avenue to the Landa Street Bridge.

Funding for the project comes from both the City of New Braunfels and the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT). Once the project design has been finalized and approved, construction will be managed by TxDOT. The project is scheduled to begin construction in 2016.
