Public's Input Sought in Development of Long-Range Capital Improvement Plan

New Braunfels, TX – The City of New Braunfels is developing a long range Capital Improvement Plan to meet the City's needs today and into the future. During the first phase of the plan development, they are seeking input from the public in order to begin determining which capital improvement projects should be included in the plan.

“The City's Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) identifies short, medium and long range priorities for capital projects as well as initiatives for strategic community investments,” said Bryan Woods, Capital Programs Manager. “The CIP Citizen Survey we are implementing is an important tool for gathering information about potential capital projects and understanding the needs of the community.”

“Additional information for updating the CIP will be gathered from the existing CIP plan, City Council, City staff and the City's many boards, committees and commissions,” Woods stated. “Once the initial phase of information gathering is complete, a broad list of potential projects will be compiled for consideration. As the process moves forward, staff will work with the City Council to prioritize projects in accordance with the available resources. Additional public input regarding specific potential projects will be gathered through another online survey. We encourage all citizens to participate in these surveys so that we can develop a CIP that addresses the needs of our community.”
