Cemetery Semiannual Clean Up Scheduled for Week of March 21st

New Braunfels, TX - The New Braunfels Parks and Recreation Department, along with Maintenance Management Contracting Services, has organized this year's semiannual cemetery clean up taking place during the week of March 21st. Cleanup will include tree and hedge trimming, as well as the removal of materials not in compliance with the City's ordinance.

Per City Ordinance, section 26-6, temporary markers or ornaments are not allowed. The ordinance also states that all natural or artificial flowers must be placed securely in the flower vases, and that the planting of any trees, shrubs, flowers, etc., of any type are not permitted.

"This semi-annual cleanup process helps to restore and preserve our cemeteries," said Stacey Dicke, Parks and Recreation Director.

Cleanup will take place within the Comal Cemetery and New Braunfels Cemetery starting on Monday, March 21st and will conclude on Friday, March 25th, weather and other factors permitting.
