**New Braunfels, TX** –Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) staff will conduct a Walkable Community Workshop for the California and Lakeview area on Tuesday, May 10<sup>th</sup>, from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m., at New Braunfels High School cafeteria. The school is located at 2551 Loop 337 N. in New Braunfels.

Residents from the area are encouraged to participate in planning a safer, healthier and greener transportation system to improve the community's quality of life.
