Mission Hill Park Master Plan Public Input Meeting

New Braunfels – The New Braunfels Parks and Recreation Department invites residents to share their input regarding the development of the Mission Hill Park Master Plan. The public meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, May 24th at 6:00 p.m. at Freedom Fellowship Church, located at 415 Oak Run Point.

"The Master Plan design team will propose a few conceptual plans that reflect a majority of desires from the previous public input meeting," said Stacey Dicke, Parks and Recreation Director. "Residents are encouraged to attend and comment on the proposed plans - the feedback will assist the design team in developing the final design."

Mission Hill Park is located at 2100 Independence Drive, adjacent to the WestPoint Village shopping center. The 10 acre natural area features wooded and open areas and magnificent views of the city and surrounding area. The land was dedicated to the New Braunfels Park Foundation in 2012 and a contract with Schrickel, Rollins and Associates (SRA) for development of a Master Plan was approved by City Council in January 2016.
