Landa Park and Arboretum Master Plan Online Survey

New Braunfels, Texas – The City of New Braunfels Parks and Recreation Department is hosting an online survey to gather resident input for the Landa Park and Arboretum Master Plan. Residents are invited to take the short survey and share their thoughts and ideas on the project.

“Landa Park is a beloved place for residents and visitors from across the region,” said Stacey Dicke, Parks and Recreation Director. “The feedback we receive is essential to ensure that the Master Plan reflects the community’s vision for Landa Park.”

The design team, Asakura Robinson, will work to develop the plan through October of 2016 using a multi-faceted strategy, including collaboration with the Master Plan Steering Committee, a stakeholder group and the general public. Among areas that will be addressed during the process are key concerns outlined in the adopted 2010 New Braunfels Strategic Parks and Recreation Master Plan such as improving wayfinding signage, arboretum tree health and preservation, traffic and pedestrian safety and circulation, parking, and refurbishment of key structures and facilities.
