Water Release from Canyon Lake Dam Provides Training Opportunity

New Braunfels, TX – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is releasing water from Canyon Lake, which means increased river flows on the Guadalupe River through New Braunfels.

The New Braunfels Fire Department will take advantage of the increased river flows to conduct rescue boat operation training along the Guadalupe River, with most training concentrated around the Faust and Common Street bridges.

The training will involve night training evolutions, may involve other public safety organizations, and is expected to continue through May 27th.
